

Visiting the Psi U Gamma Tau Chapter House? Here's some ways to get to:

1. **Public Transit: MARTA.** Take MARTA's Red or Gold line to the Midtown station. It is then .7 miles on foot or by Lime, Bird, Uber, or Lyft Scooter to the Haus.
 - a. You can park for free if you want to park for less than 24 hours at a MARTA station near your starting point and take MARTA to Midtown. [Check this page for more details on parking at MARTA.](#)
2. **Rideshare: Uber, Lyft.** Uber and Lyft ridesharing are always available in the area, 24/7.
3. **Parking: Free Parking** is no longer available in many of the previously-available lots, and the chapter house no longer has its own parking lot. Here are some options for where to park that are a 5 minute walk or less:
 - a. **5th Street Bridge (.3mi/5 min walk to Psi U; \$2.30 for 1 hour, +\$2/add'l hr):** Navigate to the Barnes and Noble at Tech Square ([48 5th Street NW](#)). There is metered parking along the two blocks on 5th street all the way up until the grassy area of the 5th Street bridge. If you turn down Williams street there is also metered parking. Download the **ParkMobile app** to pay for these meters on your phone, or pay by credit card at the meter. *Reliability Note:* There are about 30 spots along these few city blocks -- sometimes they fill up.
 - b. **Georgia Tech Visitors Area 6 (.3mi/5 min walk; \$2/hr, \$15 if over 6 hours):** Navigate to [828 West Peachtree Street Northwest, Atlanta, GA 30308](#). This lot's entrance is across from Barnes and Noble off of 5th street, behind the GT Parking Services office at the above address. Pay in the lot by cash or credit. A quick walk across the 5th Street Bridge and you will be at the Haus. [Check this map from Georgia Tech](#) for Area 6 to see the location in context.
 - c. **Georgia Tech Visitors Area 8 (.3mi/5 min walk; \$2/hr, \$15 if over 6 hours):** Navigate to [81 4th St NW, Atlanta, GA 30308](#). Get a ticket at the entry gate. Pay as you exit by cash or credit. [Check this map from Georgia Tech](#) for Area 8 to see the location in context.
